

SHORT NARRATIVE FILM PROGRAM




Our short narrative program surrounds an ill child with a team of notable writers, actors, and directors to produce a high-quality film which stars the child and showcases their unique story or script.











THE MAGIC BRACELET








TAMIKA LAMISON
